Next week marks the final House Week of the academic year, ending with our final **House Day on Friday 22nd May**. Throughout the week, students will have the opportunity to represent their House and compete for valuable House points in our annual 'House Volleyball Tournament'.


The **House Volleyball Tournament** will take place during lunchtimes throughout the week (please see flyer to the left). Students wishing to take part should organise a team of four students from the same House and Year Group and **sign up in the PE Office by Friday 15th May**. The competition schedule will then be shared with students.

To round off House Week, **Friday 22nd May will be House Colours Day**. Students are invited to wear a top in their House colour, such as a t-shirt, jumper or hoodie, in place of their usual shirt and tie. Students must still wear their school blazer and all other uniform expectations remain in place.
