Start of Term

Prepared for Learning

We would like to emphasise the importance of all students arriving at school each day fully prepared to learn, with the correct equipment. Being properly equipped has a significant impact on students' confidence, organisation, and ability to engage effectively in lessons.

Mathematics Equipment

In particular, we would like to draw your attention to mathematics equipment. For GCSE Mathematics, two-thirds of the examination papers are calculator papers, meaning that students must have a scientific calculator and, just as importantly, know how to use it confidently. Regular use of the same calculator in lessons is essential for developing these skills and ensuring students are fully prepared for assessments and examinations.

Daily Equipment Checklist

Students should bring the following items to school every day:

- A scientific calculator (not a basic calculator)
- Pens (black or blue and green for self-assessment) please have more than one
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Eraser
- Sharpener
- Protractor and compass (particularly for mathematics lessons)

- Glue stick
- Colours / highlighters
- Reading book
- Exercise books for lessons

Please note that the school does not have a free stock of equipment available to lend out. When equipment is provided in lessons, it often comes from teachers' own personal supplies, and distributing items during lessons disrupts learning time for all students. Ensuring students arrive fully equipped allows lessons to begin promptly and run smoothly.

To help prevent loss and ensure items can be returned if misplaced, we kindly ask that all equipment is clearly labelled with your child's name.
