School Uniform Requirements

- **Navy blue blazer with school badge**
- **Navy blue knee length or full-length skirt, or black tailored trousers**
- **White shirt**
- **Navy blue V neck jumper or sweatshirt with the school logo (optional)**
- **School tie** (stripe colour is dependent on year group)
- **Sensible all black shoes** (no logos)
- **Blue or black plain jacket or coat, worn over the school blazer and not in place of it.**

Logos should be minimal, and hoodies are not permitted.

- **Blue or black tights or socks**


Jewellery, Makeup and Additional Expectations

- A maximum of **two small stud earrings**
- **No facial piercings**, except for a **small single nose stud**
- **No excessive makeup or extended nails**
- **Headwear worn for religious reasons** must be plain white, black, or navy
- **Only one religious necklace**, worn discreetly under the shirt
