General information for all trips:

For all activities students will need to bring with them a packed lunch, water, sun cream and clothing suitable for the weather. Students may wear Hendon School PE kit or their own clothes for the trips. Students must wear comfortable trainers as there will be a lot of walking across the week - crocs and sandals will not be permitted and any students arriving in these will be asked to remain in school.

Food

All students should bring packed lunch and water each day. There will not be an opportunity to purchase food on the trips, however on some of the trips there may be an opportunity to buy an ice cream/snack and so students may bring a small amount of cash/card if they wish.

Students eligible for Free School Meals can order a packed lunch: sandwich, piece of fruit and bottle of water. Please complete below to order your packed lunch.

Orienteering information:

Students should attend school at 8.35am. They will be travelling to Golder's Hill Park by foot and returning by bus - therefore will need a valid student zip or oyster card. At Golder's Hill Park students will complete a small orienteering course before walking over to Hampstead Heath Pergola for lunch and games. Students will return to Hendon School at 3.10pm.

St Paul's Cathedral information:

Students should attend school at 8.35am. They will be travelling by tube to St Paul's Cathedral and will visit the dome to take in the sights of London. After visiting St Paul's Cathedral students will take a short walk around London before returning to school by tube at approximately 3.10pm.

RAF Museum information:

Students should arrive at school at 8.35am and will be travelling to the RAF museum by bus - therefore will be required to bring a valid student zip or oyster card. Whilst at the RAF Museum students will have time to explore the museum as well as take part in a workshop. Students will return to school at approximately 3.10pm

Hike information:

Students should arrive at school at 8.35am and will return to school at approximately 3.10pm. Students will be completing a 10km hike from Hendon to Totteridge.

Kew Gardens information:

Students should arrive at school at 8.35am and will be travelling to Kew Gardens by coach. Students will be leaving Kew Gardens at approximately 2pm and aim to return to school by 3.10pm. However please be aware this could be delayed based on traffic.
