



## Hendon School Home Learning Expectations

During this year, we are aware that lots of pupils have had to self-isolate due to COVID-19. This has sometimes just been a day or two but in some cases has been much longer.

### How much work should you do at home?

While pupils are isolating, it is vital that they engage with their learning as best as they can. All pupils have access to MS Teams and Frog and we would expect all pupils to spend at least 5 hours per day on their learning.

### Where is home learning provided?

All work for pupils is provided through MS Teams and Frog. Teachers will run live lessons if the whole class is isolating and will assign the classwork through Frog or Teams if part of the class is isolating. Students should complete up to 5 hours of work at home according to their timetabled lessons each day. Teachers will communicate directly via MS Teams if you have to self-isolate.
